# ETHICAL REASONING DIAGNOSTIC CARD

## ETHICAL SENSITIVITY

- Is this really an **ethical dilemma**?
  - *Why? Why not? How does this situation make you feel?*

## ETHICAL JUDGEMENT

- Who are the **Stakeholders** involved?
- What are the relevant **Rules, Outcomes & Values**?
  - *Any **Transgressions of Rules and regulations**? **Harm** (physical/psychological/emotional) caused? **Values in conflict**?*

## ETHICAL INTENTION

- What **Internal factors** affect your choices?
  - *Motivation, Commitment, Fatigue, Convenience, etc.*
- What **External factors** affect your choices?
  - *Factor types: Personal, Professional, Social, Family, Organisational, Political, Financial, Economic, etc.*
- Do you need to mitigate any of the 10 threats?

## ETHICAL BEHAVIOUR

- Do you have the **Moral Courage** to act on your intention and/or decision?
